[transition music]

Narrator: Lord Banks, Monica and JJ managed to dig themselves out of the bunker in South Carolina. When they reached the surface, the sun was bright and a calm breeze touched their dirty faces. JJ decided to stay behind and guard over Cody in his weakened condition. The mother and daughter agreed and carried on. In the distance, they heard horrific screams and evil cries. They stealthy moved about to a nearby town, which was largely devoid of people. Once they found an abandoned building with supplies, they returned to retrieve JJ and help her carry Cody.

Back at the Grand Castle, the king sat on the floor of his private reading room. He lit three candles and spoke to himself about the present state of affairs in his kingdom. But he heard a voice he did not expect to hear --coming from the shadows dancing on the walls that surrounded him. [boom]

Asilas: How did I arrive at this juncture? How could I have been so blind --not to see where this road would lead. I know I associated myself with dirty politicians in my life. So many sins I committed. Some so horrible, I cringe just to think of them. These gross acts I had to do to win the favor of powerful men and women. [transition music]

Jacob: He hasn't left yet, so that's a good sign.

Isaac: He could be collecting all the intel he can before he heads back.

Jacob: I don't get that impression. Look, let's just call him over here and get some things straight. [louder] Hey, Gabriel!

Isaac: [whispering] Wait. Jacob. [footsteps in the bushes]

Gabriel: What's going on? Have you devised a plan?

Jacob: What we need to establish first is where your loyalties lay.

Gabriel: MY loyalties?

Jacob: Gabriel, you know whatever we decide to do, we cannot do it without you. If our plan, whatever it is we decide to do, if it's going to work, we need you to be behind us.
